The ENACT Parent Advisory Committee is comprised of 15 parents from our full partnership schools and staff. The Parent Advisory Committee meets every other month to learn about the different **resources and tools** they can utilize to better support their children, like the Department of Ed's ARIS Parent Link to stay informed on progress in school. The committee creates a **community of encouragement and support** for ENACT parents and guardians.

During meetings, the Parent Advisory Committee will strategize and brainstorm to pinpoint tactics that increase opportunities for caregivers to get involved with their children at school. In addition to meetings, the PAC is bolstered through social events, such as a summer picnic and attending shows.
